

Teen bully gets probation

An Ontario elementary school bully was sentenced yesterday to 18 months on probation and was ordered to supply a blood sample for the national police databank of violent offenders after beating up an eighth-grade classmate. The boy was 14 and in Grade 8 at a Windsor elementary school in April when he and a friend planned an attack on a classmate. When the final bell rang, the accomplice held the victim against a wall in the school while the boy punched the classmate in the head, bloodying his face and knocking out his front tooth.
